



# **Best Start Pregnancy Release Notes V1.5**


#### 1. Recording Consent

Metro Auckland Data Stewards approved sharing of data with NHC provided the health professional conducting the assessment informs women that their data is going to be shared with a 3<sup>rd</sup> party entity.

The non-identifiable data is solely for the purpose of evaluation and improving outcomes for hapū Māmā and their pēpi, particularly pēpī Māori. It was agreed a 'tick box' would indicate that the woman has given verbal consent to data collection for the purpose of the Gen2040 Project. For those who do not provide consent, the form can still be used but the data is not collected. This is a short-term solution until the Gen2040 Project Team has sought advice from a national ethics committee. The consent will be seen on the Pregnancy tab.

The *information button* activates a descriptive summary of the data collection request for the Gen2040 equity project. This should act as a guide. The Information Sheet can be printed and shared with hāpū Māmā.





#### 2. Change to Test

Updated to define weeks








### 3. Add Baby-submission

If the number of previous babies recorded does not match parity, this no longer prevents the risk assessment from being submitted.

#### 4. Decision Support Updates

The main change is to how SGA and Eclampsia is handled – this has been combined into a single decision support element for prescribing Aspirin to avoid duplication when both risks are present. (The text below varies depending on the exact circumstances – see the Decision Support Reference for full details)



If unsure of EDD, now shows eligibility for a free scan.



Rule to check fundal height now triggered if LMP is unknown <u>OR</u> irregular periods > 8 weeks since date of LMP (note change of wording).



#### 5. Previous Miscarriage

New fields to record miscarriages.







## 6. Improvements to PDF output

Error resolved where some information about previous miscarriages was not included in the PDF version of the risk assessment.
